**Title:** Decisions, Decisions® : The Environment

**Subject:** Science (Environmental Problem Solving, Technology, Environmental Issues, Systems)

**Grade Level:** Grade 6

**Outcome:**

The purpose of the following activity is to:

1. Allow students the opportunity to learn about the many aspects of an environmental crisis.
2. Allow students to role play different characters in this crisis.
2. Allow students to see the complexity of environmental issues.
3. Allow students to gain an understanding of systems-thinking.
4. Encourage students to listen to other perspectives and to engage in productive dialogue.
5. Correspond with the “Curriculum Focus” as outlined in the Atlantic Canada Science Curriculum Foundation:

*“(To) encourage responsible action toward living things and the environment, and to consider issues related to sustainability from a variety of perspectives.”*

and
